- Valid professional designation or certificate in the Province of BC in biology, environmental planning, or similar discipline is desirable.
- A minimum of 5 years of related progressive experience, preferably in a municipal government setting, and can demonstrate the following skills and competencies:
 - Extensive experience in developing environmental engagement and behavioral change programs;
 - Experience in environmental bylaw enforcement and developing enforcement strategies;
 - Sound knowledge of the principles, processes and practices related to corporate and community policy development, environmental planning and federal and provincial legislation;
 - Considerable experience in project management and budget management;
 - Excellent interpersonal skills, including facilitation, collaboration, conflict resolution and relationship building;
 - Excellent verbal and written communication skills; and
 - Demonstrated leadership and management skills.
